# HOW TO REQUEST AN ABSENTEE BALLOT (aka MAIL-IN VOTING)

## HOW TO GET A MAIL-IN OR ABSENTEE BALLOT



**1. You must be a registered voter to apply for a mail-in or absentee ballot.**

a. This is the only requirement due to the new ballot proposal.



**2. Fill out an online application at <https://mvic.sos.state.mi.us/>**

a. Submit it by 5 p.m. the Friday before Election night.



**3. Submit an application from <https://mvic.sos.state.mi.us/> through the mail as a postcard or letter.**

a. Requests for absent voter ballots may be returned by hand, via postal mail, fax or email, as long as a signature is visible.

b. Mail your request by 5 p.m. the Friday before Election night.

## HOW TO VOTE WITH AN ABSENTEE BALLOT



- The ballot must be returned by 8 p.m. on election day.
- Your ballot must have your signature on the return envelope that matches your signature on file.
- If you received assistance voting the ballot, then the signature of the person who helped you must also be on the return envelope.
- Only you, a family member or person residing in your household, a mail carrier, or election official is authorized to deliver your signed absent voter ballot to your clerk's office.
