

How to Vote

APIAVote – Michigan

1. Are you registered to vote?

ONLINE



Register online through **mvic.sos.state.mi.us/RegisterVoter** or searching up “Michigan online voter registration”

VOTE BY MAIL



Search up “Michigan voter registration form” and print it out. Fill out the form and mail it to your local election office. **The voter registration deadline is 15 days before Election Day so postmark your mail by October 19, 2020.**

IN-PERSON



As Michigan residents you can register to vote at any time up to 8 p.m. on Election Day at your city or township clerk’s office. **Find a polling place at vote.org/polling-place-locator/** to cast your ballot on November 3, 2020. Polls are open from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. local time. You have the right to vote if you are in line by 8 p.m.

2. What do I need?

REQUIREMENTS



To register in Michigan you must:

- Be a citizen of the United States
- Be 18 years old by the next election
- Be a resident of Michigan and at least a 30 day resident of your city or township by Election Day
- Not be confined in a jail after being convicted and sentenced

ID if you vote in person, but if you don’t have one you can still vote. A poll worker will just ask you to fill out a form that explains that you didn’t have an ID and your vote will still be counted!

- **Valid IDs** – Michigan driver’s license or state-issued ID card, Driver’s license or personal identification card issued by another state, Federal or state government-issued photo identification, U.S. passport, Military ID with photo
- Student ID with photo from a high school or accredited institution of higher learning, Tribal ID card with photo

3. Tips for Voting!

Register to vote now!
Send in your ballot by mail now if you’re voting by mail!

Be prepared to take time off and bring snacks if you’re voting in person, and find your polling place now.
